Justices,

On March 13, 2014 it was noted that there had been placed campaign literature by the Pereira-Bybee Campaign in elevators and bathrooms in the Joe Crowley Student Union. As shown here:

This is a violation of elections code as seen in SAS 502.12.e.4 which reads:

"Willfully placing campaign material in any University building, including classrooms, libraries, bathrooms, and on chalkboards, but excluding the posting of campaign material on public access bulletin boards and kiosks within University buildings"



The material has since, and was promptly, removed upon Pereira-Bybee's being informed that the location was prohibited; the violation was denied to be an action of any agent that would be under the power of the Pereira-Bybee campaign per SAS 502.12.g.

These charges have been filed to ensure the integrity of the Statutes of the Associated Students, the legitimacy of this election cycle, and prevent further infractions - although this infraction may not warrant punitive action.
