An Act

To Recognize Revenues from Homecoming

*Whereas*, the revenues from the Big Sean homecoming concert ought to be recognized in the Association's general revenues and re-distributed to the boards that hosted the concert to cover expenses;

*Whereas*, revenues from homecoming t-shirts sales through the Nevada Wolfshop should be recognized in the Traditions account, as the board designed and sold the shirts;

*Whereas*, there are extra funds in the ASUN Center for Student Engagement account that will not be used and should be distributed elsewhere;

*Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students,*

- a) The "Student Fees" line item in the General Revenues account (1702-105-0101) shall now read "2,032,016.79."
- b) The "Operating" line item in the Traditions Board account (1702-105-0132) shall now read "84,470.16."
- c) The "Operating" line item in the Programming Board account (1702-105-0111) shall now read "176,683.56."
- d) The "Classified Salaries" line item in the ASUN Center for Student Engagement account (1702-105-0112) shall now read "29,648.58"

The "Uncommitted" line item in the Budget and Finance Committee account (1702-105-0102) shall now read "38,614.27"

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
