AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SPEAKER'S TASK FORCE ON ASSOCIATION OUTREACH

Whereas, ASUN is constantly searching for ways to improve outreach efforts for events, programs, and services that are offered to the student body, faculty, and community of all different interests;

Whereas, a Task Force with members from areas across campus will allow for diversified ideas and an honest, unbiased final report;

Whereas, Joint Vision 2017's Full Spectrum Engagement Model suggests data-driven decision-making, and ASUN's data specifically regarding current outreach efforts are minimal;

Whereas, reports submitted by the Task Force can act as a guiding light for ASUN's outreach efforts in the future;

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students, a "Speaker's Task Force on Association Outreach" is hereby established for the remainder of the 82nd Session of Senate, or until the purpose/mission of the Task Force is deemed as completed and a final report is submitted to the Senate;

Be it further enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students, the Speaker shall be required to form a task force consisting of students or faculty representing each of the following entities: the Residence Hall Association, Athletics, the Nevada Sagebrush, Fraternity and Sorority Life, the Mathewson-IGT Knowledge Center, the Joe Crowley Student Union, ASUN Clubs and Organizations, the School of the

Arts, non-traditional students, the Center for Cultural Diversity, the Honors Program, and any other campus entities deemed necessary;

Be it further enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students, the Task Force shall be charged with organizing focus groups, surveys, and/or identifying other strategies that can be used to research how ASUN's outreach can be improved not only to its constituents but also to campus employees and into the community;

Be it further enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students, all general meetings of the Task Force shall follow NRS 241, commonly referred to as Nevada Open Meeting Law;

Be it further enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students, the Speaker shall provide reports on any updates from the Task Force at the weekly ASUN Senate meetings.
