## A RESOLUTION TO AMEND SENATOR OFFICE HOURS

*Whereas*, the Senators of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Session of the Senate of the Associated Students wish to be as accessible as possible.;

*Whereas*, students rarely come to the current location for senate office hours (the Senate Workroom).;

*Whereas*, the University of Southern California requires senators to perform half of their office hours outside the office and the University of Washington, Vancouver requires senators to post their office hours on the student government website.;

*Be it resolved that*, the last two sentences of Rule II.g.1 shall read: Of the two required hours one must take place at the Senate table in the Mathewson-IGT Knowledge Center. The other is up to the discretion of each senator with approval from the Speaker.;

*Be it further resolved that*, the last two sentences of Rule II.g.3 shall read: Senators who choose to hold office hours outside of the Senate workroom or not at the Senate table are required to obtain approval from the Speaker. If office hours are held outside of the Senate workroom or not at the Senate table, senators must indicate so on the sign in sheet and record them within 24 hours of holding them.;

*Be it further resolved that*, a subsection 8 shall be created under Rule II.g which shall read: Senators are required to post the date, time, and location for their regular office hours on the ASUN website and indicate any additional office hours or changes to their regular office hours on the ASUN website before said change or additional hours.

*Be it further resolved that,* a subsection 9 shall be created under Rule II.g which shall read: Speaking at three classes, clubs, or events shall count as one office hour as long as senators submit a form signed by the teacher/leader of the class, club, or event verifying that they did speak at the class, club, or event. Senators may count speaking at classes that they are enrolled in or clubs that they are members of toward 50% of their non-tabling office hours.
