Whereas, certain departments such as the Department of Programming need to appoint interns before the start of the semester to help with start-of-the-semester events;

Whereas, internship programs appeal primarily to freshmen and transfer students, and the programs are advertised sufficiently during summer orientation programs;

- c)* SAS V.504.4.b shall be amended to read, “Applications will open and close at the discretion of the Director.”
- d)* SAS V.505.4.b shall be amended to read, “Applications will open and close at the discretion of the Director.”
- e)* SAS V.506.4.b shall be amended to read, “Applications will open and close at the discretion of the Chief Justice.”

SAS V.507.4.b shall be amended to read, “Applications will open and close at the discretion of the Assistant Director.”
