AN ACT TO REMOVE PAPER QUALITY DUTIES OF THE SPEAKER OF THE SENATE IN THE SAS

Whereas, the active roles of the Speaker of the Senate should be accurately presented in the SAS;

Whereas, the Speaker does not need to determine the quality of the paper in which bills are printed
on;

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students,

- a) SAS 101.02.b.12 be struck.
- b) SAS 103.05 be struck.
- c) SAS 103.04 be amended to read, “Every bill in the Senate shall, when such bill has passed the Senate, be printed, and such printed copy shall be called the enrolled bill, and shall be signed by the presiding officer of the Senate and presented to the President of the Associated Students. The presiding officer of the Senate is mandated to sign all acts within five working days of the meeting of the Senate during which an act was passed. Only a single copy of an enrolled bill shall be prepared, but additional copies may be prepared so long as they are endorsed as copies on the first page. During the last two weeks of a session such enrolling of bills may be done otherwise than as above prescribed, upon the order of the Senate by resolution.”
