## AN ACT TO CREATE THE SUSTAINABLE NEVADA INITIATIVE FUND

*Whereas*, the University of Nevada, Reno currently has no program for students to propose ideas and projects to make campus more sustainable;

*Whereas*, one of the University of Nevada, Reno's goals in the most updated mission statement is to "Enhance sustainable environmental quality in Nevada";

*Whereas*, creating projects that further sustainability on campus will allow for a greener environment within the grounds of the University.

*Whereas*, each student can have a different say on which aspects of sustainability are important to them by taking on unique projects proposed by the students themselves;

*Whereas*, a SNIF Committee will be created by the ASUN President to allow for fair review of sustainable projects proposed by students, and receive the just allocation of funding needed;

*Whereas*, the amount of projects each year will be determined based off of how much money is added to the account each fiscal year by the ASUN President;

*Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students,*

- a) The creation of the Sustainable Nevada Initiative Fund be added to the SAS, Title XXVI, Chapter 2601;

*Be it further enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students,*

- a) A line item be created for the "Sustainable Nevada Initiative Fund" in the "Leadership Programs" account 1702-105-0119 within which the current ASUN President will determine how much funding be allocated to the account each fiscal year.
