## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF WOLF PACK RADIO'S FM STATION

Whereas, Wolf Pack Radio is attempting to increase listenership and community involvement by broadcasting on an FM station;

Whereas, the University of Nevada already has an FM license for KUNR, but this has no bearing on Wolf Pack Radio's ability to require an FM license;

Whereas, a partnership will allow the ASUN to broadcast on FM, greatly increasing the broadcast area, popularity, and listenership of Wolf Pack Radio;

Whereas, extending the partnership will allow the Association to engage more students and community members in and around campus by providing opportunities for members to host radio shows that align with the goals and mission of Wolf Pack Radio;

Be it resolved that, the Associated Students of the University of Nevada support the creation of a Wolf Pack Radio FM station with a community partnership of the Reno Bike Project, Cuddleworks, and the Holland Project;

Be it further resolved that, a copy of this resolution be sent to Thomas Snider, the Wolf Pack Radio Manager, University of Nevada President Johnson, ASUN President Fabbi, and KUNR Representative David Stiepch
