

# Committee on University Affairs

### 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Senator Bradley called the meeting to order at 3:02 PM in Room 423 on the Fourth floor of the Mathewson-IGT Knowledge Center.

### 2. ROLL CALL

### 4. MINUTES

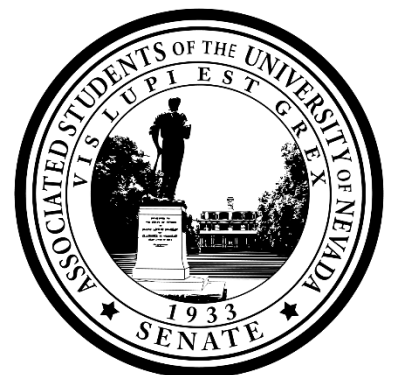
Senator Bradley asked if they needed to extend their efforts

Senator Chu asked what the liaison entails.

Senator Bradley asked Senator Crupi to elaborate on the liaison. It was added in the 83<sup>rd</sup> session.

Senator Crupi said it was added by Senator Cuevas last year. She dropped half way through. She was just meeting with non-traditional groups on campus to see what they needed. This included students who were starting at a later age

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or coming back to school. They need to be reached out to a lot. The traditional marketing ideas that they use for the general population doesn't work for them.

Senator Bradley asked if anyone was interested. It is ambiguous and broad but they could try to define it a little more.

Senator Uriquidi asked if they have a center for non-traditional students to gather on campus.

Senator Bradley said she doesn't think they do.

Senator Uriquidi asked how to reach out to them.

Senator Bradley said that is what she wanted to know as well. There isn't a club for those kinds of students. It would be hard to get in contact with those people. They need to think about those students when they are coming up with legislation. She is fine with taking it off.

Senator Crupi said that they should reach out to Dr. Beattie to see if there is a resource on campus that they can go to before taking it off. If there is an option, they can do that.

Senator Bradley asked if there are other liaisons they want to add.

Senator Bradley moved back into Section 5: Liaison Assignments from Section 6.c.

Senator Bradley expects everyone to get in touch with their liaisons within the next three weeks. She said that they should just introduce themselves and tell them that they would be their go to person if they need anything. Give them a business card.

The rest of the committee said theirs were fine.

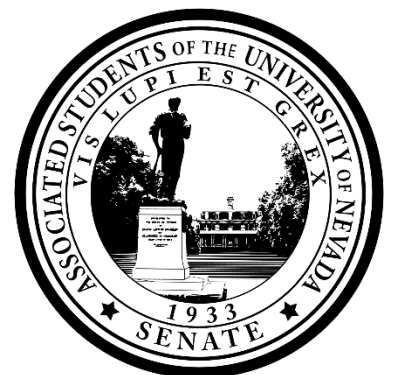
Senator Bradley said he should talk to Jacob Boulton about them.

#### b. Discussion on Establishment or Removal of Liaison Positions

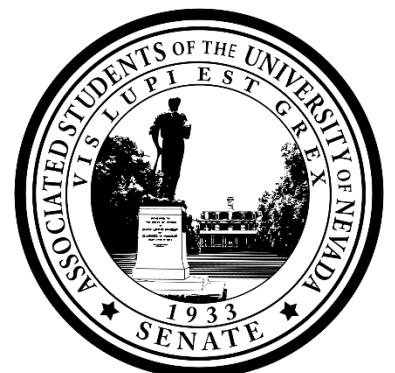
Senator Bradley said that in the Senate rules it says the committee can have liaison with University Police, Buildings and Grounds, Parking and Transportation, Campus Planning, Construction, Student Health Center Services, Student Legal Services, Counseling Center, Campus Dining, Campus Escort, Greek Councils, Residence Halls, Housing, Activity Boards, Recognized Student Organizations, Environmental Issues, which she doesn't understand that

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one, and Athletics, including ticket distribution policies. They are doing a good job but she asked if anyone had any problems with that. With those in mind, do they want to add or take away liaisons.

Senator Feng said he thought they should add Parking and Transportation. A lot of students are concerned with the issue of parking on campus.

Senator Bradley asked what they want to co-align that with or if anyone was comfortable taking that on.

Senator Uriquidi said he could take it.

Senator Bradley said she agreed because when President Johnson came yesterday, the very first question was what they were doing about parking. It is a big thing that students want to know about because there is a lack of it. That is a good one to add. They pretty much hit all of them. She asked if they wanted to keep Clubs and Orgs in there.

Senator T. Jackson said Clubs and Orgs attends Senate and gives a report, so it is not necessary to have them as a liaison.

Senator Bradley agreed because they don't have liaisons with other executive or cabinet members. She doesn't know if this means all 300 clubs and organizations. Director Long does a really good job of making sure they are updated.

Senator Feng said they could add University Police. This session focus' on safety and they are a big aspect of that. They can ask them to come out to their events and help out.

Senator Bradley asked if anyone wants to take that liaison on.

Senator Chu said she would take it.

### **c. Discussion on Future Projects**

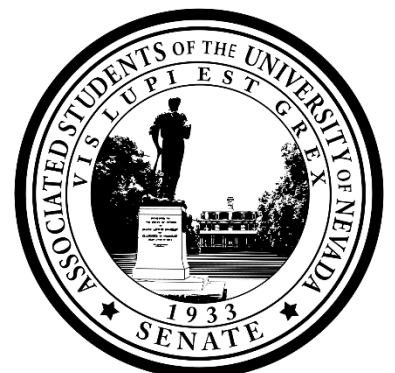
Senator Bradley said that she wants them to think about legislation that is put through for the committee to go over. They can go over anything that pertains to the university. She asked them to dig deep into their campaigns and platforms and most of it can get done in this committee. She wanted to see if anyone have projects they are looking into doing. Two of them have been senators for less than 24 hours so they get a pass this time around.

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Senator Crupi said they probably won't see legislation from him in regards to the student union. Last year, a majority of his acts were done more effectively without legislation. It is a lot easier for some of the departments to speak with the director to try to get something done. It shortens the process by more than a month to just talk to the director.

Senator Bradley said they don't always need to talk about legislation. They can talk about things that happened on campus in this committee. She asked if they knew what happened with the scholarship drinks at Starbucks and Keva Juice last year. She said she will ask about what senator was in charge of that last year because it was on the table all last year.

Senator Crupi said he thought it was Senator Upton originally but it was transferred to Senator H. Jackson.

That is an example of things that would be done in the committee. The idea behind that was that they would have a certain drink they can buy and the profit would go towards scholarships. Another example would be Senator Cook's classes on the quad could be done through the committee as well. Senator Crupi was talking about the lighting. Chief-of-Staff Atienza wants to start working with the committee on a sexual assault campaign and bring it to ASUN. He will be coming into the meeting and talking with them about what they want to do there so keep that in mind.

Senator Bradley moved back into Section Five: Liaison Assignments.
