A Bill

An Act to Add a Question on the 2018 General Elections Ballot

1 *Whereas*, the primary purpose of the University of Nevada, Reno is academic achievement;
2 Whereas, the Mathewson-IGT Knowledge Center is the main campus facility for personal and
3 group studying;
4 *Whereas*, as it currently stands, E.L. Wiegand Fitness Center is open 116 hours a week compared
5 to the 109 hours a week that the Mathewson-IGT Knowledge Center operates;
6 *Whereas*, it is necessary to gauge the students' opinion on if they would use the Mathewson-IGT
7 Knowledge Center if it was open later;
8 *Whereas*, this data will be used to further support or discourage the idea of extending the hours
9 of the Mathewson-IGT Knowledge Center;

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students,*

2 a) That a survey question be put on the 2018 General Elections Ballot for all
3 undergraduate students to participate in;

4 b) The question on the ballot shall read as the following:

5 “If the Mathewson-IGT Knowledge Center hours were extended, how likely are you to
6 use the facility after 1 AM?”

7 c) The response of the question will be a scale from one to five.
