Whereas, the WTF (What to Fix) Nevada Manager was originally implemented to oversee the WTF Nevada campaign. This was a campaign designated to reaching out to the student body in an effort to gain insight into what needed to be fixed at the University, specifically through the Associated Students of the University of Nevada. This was communicated through Facebook as well as through various campaign events;

Whereas, as ASUN has evolved we have identified new ways to communicate with constituents; therefore, WTF Nevada has not been utilized. As a result, a Manager has not been needed;

Whereas, as it stands, it is stated in the 86th Session Rules that a WTF Nevada Manager must be appointed, and by leaving this seat vacant, the Senate is violating the Session Rules;

Whereas, removing this rule will ensure up to date documentation and will also ensure the accountability and transparency of the Association;

Be it resolved that, within the Session Rules of the Senate, Rule XX Part C) WTF Nevada Manager be stricken and the Table of Contents will reflect this change.
