5. **OLD BUSINESS**

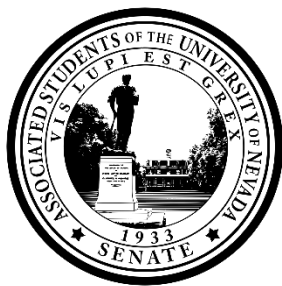
There was no old business discussed at this time.
