Dr. Beattie asked if she meant ASUN scholarships or all the scholarships on campus.

Dr. Beattie said she could talk to Jeff who came to Senate. He came from the office of financial aid.

Senator Westerman said she and Senator Ahmed were working on a resolution for a scholarship database.

Senator Harvey said she was hoping that they would reach out to those in charge of their liaison positions within the next week so they could have a working relationship with them before the summer started.

i. Faculty Senate

iii. Admissions and Records

Senator D. Hall said she wanted to be a liaison for admissions and records.

Senator Westerman asked if she could be a liason for the Career Studio even though she worked there.

Dr. Beattie said no because it was a conflict of interest. Since she worked there they had direct power over her.

iv. Libraries

Senator Ahmed, Donohue, and Westerman said there were interested in this liaison position.

Senator Collins said they should know she was drafting a resolution to have the library open longer.

Senator D. Hall said she thought multiple people assigned to one thing might cause the communication to go poorly.

Senator Ahmed said one person would be assigned officially and other Senators could come and follow.

Senator Harvey said collaboration would be fine. As long as one person was explicitly communication with their liaison position, that person could inform the other Senators on board.

Senator Harvey asked everyone to reach out to someone. She knew several of the positions would be active over the summer as well.

Senator D. Hall asked if anyone knew the head of admissions and records.

Dr. Beattie said he did.
