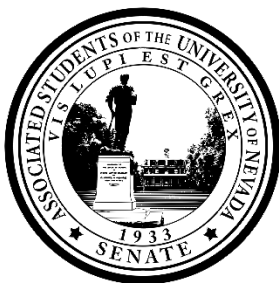

President Martinez,

Last session, Enactus had submitted a proposal to the Sustainable Nevada Initiative Fund to start a student-run recycling project on campus, in which they would collect PET materials from campus events and local businesses and then use them to create products for these businesses at a reduced cost. The SNIF Committee agreed that this project had a significant impact as well as need, however approving the project was delayed until the club had found a facility on campus to work out of.

Enactus was able to secure a facility on campus, the Applied Research Facility, and contacted me towards the end of Summer. With it being a new fiscal year, it is not possible to fund this project with the money from last year's SNIF. That being said, after discussions with Director Rodriguez I would like to request that \$5,000 from this year's Sustainable Nevada Initiative Fund be approved to fund the first stage of the proposal submitted by Enactus.

Please accept this memo to have the Executive Branch discuss and vote on the approval of these funds.
