AN ACT TO AMEND THE DUTIES OF THE CLUB COMMISSION

Whereas, currently in the SAS, in order for clubs to be recognized, they must go through the commission for approval;

Whereas, the professional staff already ensures that all clubs follow the stipulations outlined in SAS 202.08;

Whereas, to make the process of club recognition more streamlined;

Whereas, In order for clubs to more easily carry out their objectives during the summer months;

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students,

- a) The process of club recognition go through the appropriate professional staff;
- b) SAS 202.07.a be struck;
- c) SAS 202.08.a be amended so that the first sentence reads, "Any group of at least 10 members of the Association may petition for the recognition of the Association." ;
- d) SAS 202.08.a.1 be amended so that it reads, "The constitution, bylaws, or other governing document of the Club or Organization shall be submitted, and the content thereof must be in compliance with such reasonable rules and regulations that the professional staff may establish."
