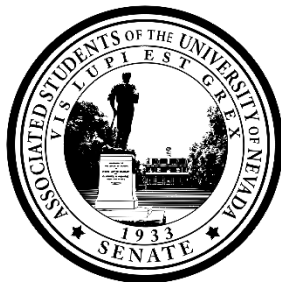
Claudia Feil, the Director of Wellness will be coming in to discuss questions senators wish to be seen on the feedback forms.
