There is no old business to discuss at this time.

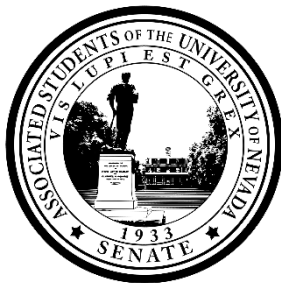
6. **NEW BUSINESS**
