Speaker Salah,

Alyah Raygoza, Senator for the School of Public Health, received a total of 5.98 points.

- During the 4-26-23 meeting of Senate, Senator Raygoza was marked Tardy Unexcused, resulting in 0.66 point.
- During the 5-24-23 meeting of Senate, Senator Raygoza was marked Tardy Unexcused, resulting in 0.66 point.
- During the 8-2-23 meeting of Senate, Senator Raygoza was marked Absent Unexcused, resulting in 2 points.
- During the 8-20-23 meeting of Senate, Senator Raygoza was marked Absent Unexcused, resulting in 2 points.
- During the 9-6-23 meeting of Senate, Senator Raygoza was marked Tardy Unexcused, resulting in 0.66 point.

Altogether, Senator Raygoza's points total five and ninety-eighth of a point.

Therefore, Alyah Raygoza Senator for the School of Public Health, is eligible for censure.
