AN ACT TO UPDATE COMPENSATION IN THE ASSOCIATION

Whereas, Title IV of the SAS covers the compensation of all Officers of the Association;

Whereas, this section is outdated as it includes old positions that no longer exist, lacks newer positions or name changes, and includes an outdated system of timesheets that no longer is utilized;

Whereas, this legislation intends to clarify expectations for pay, and was written in coordination with Assistant Director Patrick Alejaga who currently handles the Association's finances;

Whereas, the Parliamentarian has been added to the list of Senate positions that receives an additional \$500 stipend as they are the only Senate position lacking this stipend, even though they assume additional duties as with the other roles;

Whereas, the \$300 pay for Senate positions in Chapter 402 has been changed to \$500 to match the current wage paid in the fiscal year 2023 budget;

Whereas, the compensation limit for Senators inside of Chapter 401 was written to reflect the Judicial Case Schein vs. SB 90 to ensure clarity for future sessions when calculating wages;

Be it enacted, the Senate shall adopt Addendum A;

Be it further enacted, that this piece be sent to the following individuals:
