## AN ACT TO AMEND SENATOR TITLES FOR THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION AND HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

Whereas, the Associated Students of the University of Nevada currently refers to the College of Education and Human Development as the "College of Education," which fails to acknowledge the Human Development and Family Science (HDFS) department within the college;

Whereas, the College of Education was officially renamed the "College of Education and Human Development" after a faculty vote in 2020 to recognize the composition of studies within the college;

Whereas, the total undergraduate enrollment within the College of Education and Human Development, hereafter referred to as "CoEHD", in the Fall semester of 2021 is 1,181 students;

Whereas, the total undergraduate enrollment for CoEHD majors in the Fall Semester of 2021 is 603

students, 292 of which are HDFS (48% of the college's majors);

Whereas, the total undergraduate enrollment for CoEHD minors in the Fall semester of 2021 is 244 students, 185 of which are HDFS (76% of the college's minors);

Whereas, the remainder of CoEHD students are Pre-Majors in programs that specialize in teacher preparation;

Whereas, the College of Education and Human Development is recognized as such on the University of Nevada, Reno's website, the Provost's office, and CoEHD course syllabi;

Whereas, the Associated Students of the University of Nevada does not yet accurately reflect the name of the College of Education and Human Development in its governing documents, nameplates, name tags, nor website;

*Be it enacted,* the title "College of Education" in governing documents, nameplates, name tags, or website shall be amended to "College of Education and Human Development" hereafter.

Be it further enacted, the Statutes of Associated Students reflect the changes in Addendum A.
