SECTION 02: SPEAKER OF THE SENATE

3	b) DUTIES :
4	The duties of the Speaker of the Senate include, but are not limited to:
5 6	 Act as the signing authority for all accounts under control of the Senate. Administer oaths and affirmations that are or may be required by the
7	Constitution, or by law, to be taken by any Senator, officer of the Senate, witness,
8	or other person in respect to any matter within the jurisdiction of the Senate.
9	3) Call meetings of the Senate as stated by law.
10	4) Ensure that all meetings of the Senate are virtually accessible through
11	remote technology platforms to the extent practicable.
12	45) Produce the agenda for any given meeting of the Senate and give proper
13	time for officer reports, committee reports and items of business.
14	56) Direct the Senate to maintain proper decorum during meeting
15	67) Manage Senator resignations and place the announcement of such
16	resignations on the agenda.
17	78) Publicize and, at minimum, place advertisement in the Nevada Sagebrush
18	for vacant Legislative positions.
19	89) Vote in matters of business where the speaker's vote would be decisive.
20	910) Sign all Acts of the Senate within Constitutional time limit.
21	1011) Ensure Senate is following Nevada Open Meeting Law
22	1112) Determine the quality of paper on which to print enrolled bills.
23	1213) Email any legislation originally introduced within Senate or the Committee
24	on Oversight to the Legislative Clerk within 24 hours of posting the agenda.
25	1314) Act as President if, by reason of death, resignation, removal from office,
26	inability, or failure to qualify, there is neither a President nor Vice President to
27	discharge the powers and duties of the office of President.
28	1415) To serve as a member of the University Leadership Alliance.
29	1516) Responsible to attend all ASUN retreats, and trainings as decided by the
30	Chief of Internal Affairs.
