A BINDING RESOLUTIUON TO REVISE FAST TRACKING

Resolution Number: 50 Authored By: Senator Tauebel Sponsored By: 2022-2023 Student Government Assembly

Whereas, Senate Rule XVII.c states: "At the appointed time, the Speaker shall recognize all Senators who properly submitted their intent to move fast-track legislation in turn for the purpose of making such a notion. Such a motion shall be decided without debate, and shall require the consent of a two-thirds majority of the Senate";

Whereas, dissent to the motion to fast track does not allow debate, removing the opportunity to discuss the dissent;

Whereas, allowing debate can lead to relevant and important discussion;

Be it resolved that, Senate Rule XVII of the 90th Session Senate Rules should be amended to read "At the appointed time, the Speaker shall recognize all Senators who properly submitted their intent to move fast-track legislation in turn for the purpose for making such a motion. Such a motion shall require the consent of a two-thirds majority of the Senate", reflecting the changes shown in Addendum 1.
