## **A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CHANGING THE SIGNAGE ON THE WILLIAM J. RAGGIO BUILDING**

*Whereas*, the College of Education was officially renamed the “College of Education and Human Development” after a faculty vote in 2020 to recognize the composition of studies within the college;

*Whereas*, the total undergraduate enrollment within the College of Education and Human Development, hereafter referred to “CoEHD”, in the Fall semester of 2021, is 1,181 students;

*Whereas*, the total undergraduate enrollment of CoEHD majors in the Fall Semester of 2021 is 603 students, 292 of which are Human Development and Family Science (48% of the college’s majors);

*Whereas*, the remainder of CoEHD students are Pre-Majors in programs that specialize in teacher preparation;

*Whereas*, the College of Education and Human Development is recognized as such by the University of Nevada, Reno’s website, ASUN, the Provost’s office, and CoEHD course syllabi;

*Whereas*, the lettering on the West and East sides of the building read “William J. Raggio Building” and “College of Education” beneath it;

*Whereas*, many students majoring and minoring in HDFS feel underrepresented and support the inclusion of their department within the building signage on the William J. Raggio Building;

*Whereas*, the Associated Students of the University of Nevada fully supports the representation of the department of Human Development and Family Science;

*Be it resolved that*, this body recognizes the College of Education and Human Development and supports the change of all exterior building signage from “College of Education” to “College of Education and Human Development”;
