A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ATHLETICS INSTALLING PROTECTIVE NETTING BEHIND PECCOLE PARK

Whereas, UNR parking services provides parking spaces located directly behind the fence of UNR's baseball field, Peccole Park¹;

Whereas, to park in these spaces, the Blue zone 1 permit is required;

Whereas, the price of the Blue zone 1 permit is \$160 per year²;

Whereas, vehicles and people in these spaces are at risk of being damaged by baseballs hit over the fence;

Whereas, any damage done to vehicles is the responsibility of the owner; Nevada Athletics nor Parking Services are responsible;

Whereas, the price to repair a broken windshield can be as high as \$400, making repair expenses more than the price of the Blue zone permit;

Whereas, students tend to purchase the Blue zone permit due to its cheaper cost relative to the other parking passes, which range up to \$510³;

Whereas, affordable parking options are limited on campus; cheaper parking that puts students and their vehicles at risk is an issue of equity;

Whereas, athletics looked into building a net behind the field in the past, receiving a quote for the price, but have taken no action;

Be it resolved that, the Associated Students of the University of Nevada supports and strongly encourages the building of a net behind Peccole Park;
