Whereas, students have expressed a want for more transparency within their representative body;

Whereas, the association has an impactful budget funded by students, in which they have a vested interest in;

Whereas, this tracker allows the students to stay presently updated on issues that are significant to them and in which they have a stake in;

Whereas, students have the right to know the progress their representatives are making all throughout the year, even when they are a work in progress;

Whereas, this gives students an outlet to reach out to their Senators on projects they are actively working on and understand who to speak to for topics of their concern;

Whereas, this legislative tracker will keep Senators encouraged and accountable as having the Senate Body's work in the public eye will motivate Senators to actively pass legislation and follow up on the pieces they have passed;

Whereas, a legislative tracker has already been made for the session, and needs to be used more effectively;

Whereas, student input and involvement strengthen the legislative and representative process;

Whereas, the Parliamentarian shall be responsible for the publicization of the Legislative tracker and ensure it is up to date;

Addendum A**TITLE I: THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH****CHAPTER 101: COMPOSITION****SECTION 07: PARLIAMENTARIAN****a) IN GENERAL:**

The Speaker shall appoint from the membership of the Senate a Parliamentarian, subject to the majority approval of the Senate, who shall advise the Speaker and individual Senators on matters of Senate procedure, the law, and the Constitution of the Associated Students.

b) DUTIES:

- 1) The Parliamentarian shall be informally trained along with or by the Attorney General of the Association within 14 days of assuming office and shall informally train officers and department directors on parliamentary procedures.
- 2) Assume a voting position within the Committee of Oversight and the Committee on Government Operations.
- 3) Advise the Speaker and individual Senators on matters of Senate Procedure, the law, and the Constitution.
- 4) Be responsible for the publicization of the Legislative tracker and ensure it is up to date.
