### 8. NEW BUSINESS

#### a. S.B. 93 - Rename Director of Executive Affairs

Senator Moss presented a bill to rename "Director of Executive Affairs" back to "Chief of Staff" to more accurately reflect duties and reduce confusion with external partners. Motion to favorably recommend passed; bill moved to the Senate table.

#### b. S.B. 93 – Establish State of the Association Address

Bill requires the ASUN President to deliver a "State of the Association" address twice each session (fall and spring). Motion to favorably recommend passed; bill moved to the Senate table.

## c. S.B. 93 - Amend Compensation for Chairs of Special Committees

Bill revises stipend structure, removing appointed officer Level 4 stipend for special committee chairs to emphasize commitment over compensation. Motion to favorably recommend passed; bill moved to the Senate table.

#### d. S.B. Resolution 93 - Amend Duties and Procedures for Special Committees

Resolution clarifies that special committees do not count toward senators' required committee membership. Motion to favorably recommend passed; resolution moved to the Senate table.
