a. Presentation from the Department of Government Affairs

Assistant Director Hatch, Policy Director Atencio, Projects Director Zotchi and Advocacy Director Casey provided an overview of the ASUN Department of Government Affairs. The discussion highlighted the department's ongoing efforts to foster civic engagement and strengthen connections between students and local and state government entities. The department was noted for its collaboration with other areas of ASUN and student leaders to organize voter registration drives, civic education programs, and community involvement initiatives. Emphasis was placed on ensuring that student voices are represented in governmental processes and that opportunities for active participation in civic life continue to expand.

- a. Committee member reports
  - i. Chair Issa The Chair thanked the Department of Government Affairs for their presentation and noted appreciation for the insightful questions raised

by committee members. He shared that he had completed most of his one-on-one check-ins with members, observing a common desire for greater collaboration among ongoing projects. Moving forward, the Chair stated that discussion items will be added to the agenda for each project to encourage broader input from senators. Members were reminded that they may collaborate with others even outside of their liaison appointments—for example, assisting with the planning of the Veterans Day Luncheon. The Chair also announced that at the next Senate meeting, the Office of Government and Community Engagement will present on ways ASUN can better collaborate with their office.

- iii. Senator Castro Senator Castro reported on a recent meeting with Austin Daly from the Office of Government and Community Engagement. Topics included reviving last year's *Discussions in Democracy* event, with potential participation from Nevada legislative leaders, and launching an initiative to help students join local boards or neighborhood councils through an interest-based form that matches them with civic opportunities in their area.

- vi. Senator Radtke Senator Radtke shared that she and the Chair met with the Director of Government Affairs to plan an event focused on voter registration and education. She added that they will meet with the Director of IDEA to continue planning and invited other members to participate in organizing the event.
- vii. Senator Saporito Senator Saporito noted plans to meet with the Office of Service Learning and Community Engagement to discuss ongoing collaborations, though a prior meeting had to be rescheduled due to an exam.
