S.R. 93 -
A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST CLARITY
ON THE ROLLOUT OF PACK AI

IN THE SENATE OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS

AUGUST 20TH, 2025

SUBMITTED TO THE SENATE OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS BY
PARLIAMENTARIAN ISSA CO-SPONSORED BY SENATOR BARRUS & SENATOR
MCANDREWS

Whereas, Associated Students of the University of Nevada (ASUN) represents the voice of the undergraduate student body in matters affecting student academic and campus life;

Whereas, much of the student body has expressed questions and concerns regarding the scope, purpose, and impacts of PACK AI's implementation;

Whereas, it is essential that students are fully informed about changes that directly affect their educational tools, data, and academic experiences;

Whereas, a select group of Senators met with Provost Jeff Thompson and Vice President of Student Services Heather Speed, who shared their vision of expanding opportunities for University of Nevada students in the area of artificial intelligence;

Whereas, many of the concerns raised by the undergraduate student body and the Senate of the Associated Students regarding PACK AI were addressed by Provost Thompson at the aforementioned meeting;

Whereas, University leadership values students' inputs and concerns regarding academic wellbeing, opportunity and future;

Whereas, PACK AI is not a mandatory implementation to the student body, rather a means to provide opportunities for undergraduate students within the University and for students' futures;

Whereas, the personal data of students using PACK AI services will not be collected by third-party companies and will not be used to train any artificial intelligence model;

Whereas, there is no fiscal implication for students or the broader University to implement PACK AI;

Whereas, the University is using staff and faculty that are already researching and contributing to the development of artificial intelligence to implement PACK AI, and have not hired any additional faculty for the purpose of integrating PACK AI;

Whereas, the implementation of PACK AI provides students with the opportunity to explore artificial intelligence and its potential applications to their academic and professional careers;

Whereas, the Associated Students of the University of Nevada supports the University's mission to provide opportunities for students to succeed in achieving their academic and professional goals;

Whereas, this resolution does not take a stance on the use of artificial intelligence or PACK AI itself, but rather emphasizes the importance of transparency and student awareness prior to implementation;

Whereas, the ASUN Senate wishes to be informed on this issue in order to provide full transparency to the student body; and

Whereas, the Associated Students of the University of Nevada continues to foster the relationship with University Administration, in order to best serve the students of the University of Nevada, Reno;

Be it resolved, that the Associated Students of the University of Nevada formally request the University Administration provide a presentation to the ASUN Senate regarding the implementation of PACK AI, including but not limited to its intended functions, impacts on academic platforms data usage policies, data protection and privacy, student support resources and effects on students fees;

Be it further resolved, that University Administration provide a public announcement to every student addressing impacts on academic platforms, data usage policies, data protection and privacy, student support resources and effects on students fees;

Be it further resolved, that ASUN urges University Administration to make this information available not only to student leadership but also to the broader undergraduate student body, ensuring clarity and transparency in how PACK AI will be integrated into existing academic systems; and that this informed implementation process supports the integrity of ASUN's role in representing students while also reinforcing the leadership of University Administration in carrying out changes that directly affect students;

Be it further resolved, that the ASUN Senate requests that all of the above take place prior to the conclusion of the Fall 2025 semester, to allow adequate time for student input;

Be it further resolved, that ASUN urges University Administration to provide continued updates to student leadership throughout PACK AI's rollout; and

Senator Issa & Senator McAndrew's Proposed Amendments

Whereas Clauses

1. Modify Neutrality Clause

- *Motion: "I move to amend S.R. 93 by striking the Whereas clause: 'Whereas, this resolution does not take a stance on the use of artificial intelligence or PACK AI itself, but rather emphasizes the importance of transparency and student awareness prior to implementation;' and inserting in its place: 'Whereas, this resolution does not take a position on the use of artificial intelligence, but instead seeks to highlight the academic and professional opportunities made available by the University;'"*

2. Modify Transparency Clause

- *Motion: "I move to amend S.R. 93 by striking the Whereas clause: 'Whereas, the ASUN Senate wishes to be informed on this issue in order to provide full transparency to the student body;' and inserting in its place: 'Whereas, the ASUN Senate wishes to be informed on the implications of PACK AI in order to provide full awareness to the student body;'"*

Be it resolved Clauses

1. Modify Presentation Clause

- *Motion: "I move to amend S.R. 93 by changing the first Be it resolved clause to read: 'Be it resolved, that the Associated Students of the University of Nevada formally request that University Administration provide a presentation to the Senate of the Associated Students regarding the implementation of PACK AI, including but not limited to its intended functions, impacts on academic platforms and curriculum, data usage policies, data protection and privacy, student support resources and effects on students fees;'"*

2. Replace Public Announcement Clause

- *Motion: "I move to amend S.R. 93 by striking the second Be it further resolved clause beginning 'that University Administration provide a public announcement...' and inserting in its place: 'Be it further resolved, that the Associated Student of the University of Nevada formally request University Administration to inform students of available opportunities, address potential concerns, and communicate their vision for how PACK*

AI may support students and their future endeavors;”

3. Shorten Transparency Clause

- *Motion: “I move to amend S.R. 93 by striking the third Be it further resolved clause beginning ‘that ASUN urges University Administration to make this information available not only to student leadership...’ through the end of that clause, and inserting in its place: ‘Be it further resolved, that ASUN urges University Administration to provide continued updates to student leadership throughout PACK AI’s rollout;”*

4. Strike Deadline Clause

- *Motion: “I move to amend S.R. 93 by striking the Be it further resolved clause: ‘that the ASUN Senate requests that all of the above take place prior to the conclusion of the Fall 2025 semester, to allow adequate time for student input;”*
