The **IDEA Grant** is a \$1,500 funding opportunity, awarded equally to TWO students, organizations, clubs, who demonstrate a strong commitment to Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Access (IDEA) at the University of Nevada, Reno. This initiative, proudly presented by the Associated Students of the University of Nevada (ASUN) through the Department of IDEA, supports students who are passionate about creating a more inclusive campus environment.

This grant is specifically designed for students who submit a proposal for an **event or initiative** that promotes the values of IDEA on campus. Applicants are encouraged to creatively implement programs, events, or projects that foster cultural awareness, inclusivity, and equitable access for all students.

How to Participate:

- **Application submission:** submit an application detailing an event or initiative idea that aligns with IDEA's core values by (DATE HERE) (application form link here)

- **Proposal format:** Attach a Word document describing how your project or event will promote inclusion, diversity, equity, and access across the UNR community. (DRAFT WORD DOC INSERT HERE)
- **Funding:** Two selected applicants will each receive \$750 in funding, distributed on (DATE HERE, prior to showcase fair event).
- **Event timeline:** Funded events or initiatives must be executed in **February, March, or April** with support from the Department of IDEA.
